1972 was a year of continued, steady growth in the ministries of Faith Center's radio and television facilities. The largest step forward was, of course, the finalizing of the transfer to Faith Center, of WHCT, Channel 18 in Hartford, Connecticut.

Acquisitions of new equipment for KHOF-TV were perhaps not as spectacular as in some past years, but contributed much to improvement in our efficiency of operation and general on-air presentation. Two new high-band 2" video-tape recorders, were added to the facilities at Glendale, and another high-band machine was installed at Sunset Ridge. A color film camera was also brought from Hartford, and installed in the KHOF-TV upstairs studio.

In the Radio Department, a new production studio was completed for KHOF, and new main studios were built for KIFM in Bakersfield.

The two major projects facing the Engineering Department in 1973, will be construction of Channel 38, in San Francisco, and construction of new television production studios in Glendale. Another important project is the upgrading of the studio equipment at the KHOF-TV transmitter at Sunset Ridge.
